



## Books/E-Books

Books are arranged by Library of Congress call numbers. To locate books, check the Library's online catalog to obtain a call number. There are help screens built into the catalog, and library staff is available to assist you. Library cards may be obtained at the Circulation Desk on the 1st floor, South Wing (S-1). Circulating books with call numbers A-N are shelved on N-2 (North Wing, 2nd floor & P-Z are on N-3.



## Periodicals

Print periodicals are shelved alphabetically by title on the 1st floor of the Central (C-1) & North (N-1) Wing. To determine whether a periodical – online or print, is in the collection, check the *Journals* link on the library web site or go to the following:

## Newspapers

Current print issues of selected local, state & national newspapers are shelved on the 2nd floor of the Central Wing (C-2). Some are retained permanently on microfilm. Online access is available through the *Online Databases* link from the library web site.

## Printers/Copiers

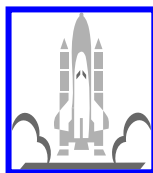


Copiers take change & bills (10¢/page) or Charger Cards (6¢/page). All computer printing is 10¢/page for black & white or \$1.00/page for color. Payment for computer printing is via *Charger Cards* or a print card obtained from the Circulation Desk. Downloading to personal diskettes is free. You may purchase a floppy disk for \$1.50 at the Circulation Desk.



## Microforms

Microforms are on the West side of the North Wing, 1st Floor (N-1). There is a 10¢ charge per page for printing microforms. A reader is located adjacent to the Microform area in N-1. Both a *Microfiche* & a *Microfilm* reader/printer reader are located in C-1. Salmon library also offers a *Microform Copy Service*. See the Reference Desk for more details on this service.

The Salmon Library maintains a collection of over 375,000 books & e-books & over 20,000 e-journals & 900 current print journals. It also provides access for 350 electronic information sources.

## Reference

Encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, bibliographies, guides, periodical & newspaper indexes, & other reference materials are located on the 1st floor, South Wing (S-1). The Reference Desk is staffed by librarians to assist users until 10 PM Sunday through Thursday, until 6 PM Friday and Saturday.



## Government Documents



The Library is a *Selective Depository* for U.S. Government documents. These publications may be identified & located through specialized indexes with the assistance of Government Documents faculty, staff or Reference Librarians. The MARCIVE index to government publications may be accessed through Library web site. Documents are housed on the Lower Level, Central Wing.
